Dear Parent/Carer,

All Year 11 students will be sitting their mock examinations between Thursday 1st – Tuesday 13th December.

Students should arrive at school as normal at 8.20am for am registration each day. The school day will end slightly earlier on a few occasions when students have afternoon exams; please check the attached timetable carefully. When students do not have an exam they will be in normal timetabled lessons or boosters.

It is vital students understand the importance of these exams. They provide an opportunity for students to practise completing examinations in subjects they study. In some areas the grades will inform tiers of entry (foundation/higher papers) and the sets that students are placed in for certain subjects.

It is important that your son/daughter is preparing for these examinations at home. They should be revising using revision guides, their exercise books, revision websites and past papers on the internet. All students have participated in a study skills session where they have been introduced to a variety of revision and preparation methods that will help them with exam preparation the resources from the live parent event have been posted on the exams section of the school website

The examination timetable is attached. Please read through it with your son/daughter to make sure they know when they have an examination. Please display a copy of the exam timetable at home and ensure that your son/daughter has their own copy.

Please help your son/daughter to do their best in the examinations by reinforcing the examination expectations outlined below:

- Arrive on time to all exams in full school uniform.
- Line up sensibly in the playground before the start of each exam.
- Enter the venue in silence, put bags and coats in the allocated place in the hall and then take their seats as quickly as possible without talking.
- Have the correct equipment for each examination – at least 2 pens (should be black ink), pencils, rubber, ruler and any subject specific equipment necessary. This equipment should be kept in a plastic, see-through bag.
- Mobile phones must be turned off, and either left at home or in their bags. Phones cannot be in students' pockets during exams.

Students' conduct in these exams must be perfect. Failure to behave in any manner other than that may result in non-entry for final examinations at our centre.

I hope all students achieve well in these exams. Good results should show students what they are capable of achieving; poor results should encourage students to take responsibility for their progress and address where they went wrong.

Students will receive their results when we return to school in January and a copy of their outcomes will be sent home to you week beginning **Monday 16th January.**
