We are planning to invite students on site to collect their examination results. As well as receiving their results, students will be able to access support with any queries about sixth form options and other pathways.

Students should use the Burr Road entrance. If guidance concerning Covid-19 restrictions changes and we need to make any changes to these arrangements, we will keep you informed via the Academy website.

If your son or daughter is unable to collect their examination results in person, they may nominate another person to collect them. In order to arrange this, please use your email address on record at the academy to send a request to [exams@southfieldsacademy.com](mailto:exams@southfieldsacademy.com). The nominated person should bring proof of ID when collecting the results. Uncollected results will be posted home.

Students who have applied to re-join the sixth form will be required to attend an enrolment interview once they have collected their examination results on August 12th.

Although the process of awarding examination results has been different this year, we are confident that the process has been rigorous and that grades awarded are a fair reflection of the students' performance. We are therefore not making any changes to our entry criteria for our students to sixth form courses. If a student has changed their mind about a course they requested at their first interview, we will endeavour to enable them to change if they have met the entry criteria. If a student has not met the entry criteria for their chosen course, we will advise them of alternatives available.

On a separate note, if a student believes that something has gone wrong in determining a grade they are awarded this summer, they can request a centre review and an awarding organisation appeal. More information is available on the academy website concerning this process and can be accessed here:
