Examination Regulations

- 1 Be on time for all your exams. If you are late, your work might not be accepted.
- 2 Do not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the exam.
- 3 If you try to cheat, or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your subjects.
- 4 You must not take into the exam room: (a) notes; (b) an iPod, a mobile phone, a MP3/4 player or similar device, or a watch.
- 5 Any pencil cases taken into the exam room must be see-through. Remember: possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules, even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.
- 6 If you have a watch, the invigilator will ask you to hand it to them.
- 7 Do not use correcting pens, fluid or tape, erasable pens, highlighters or gel pens in your answers.
- 8 Do not talk to or try to communicate with, or disturb other candidates once in the venue. Remain facing forward when seated.
- 9 You must not write inappropriate, obscene or offensive material.
- 10 If you leave the exam room unaccompanied by an invigilator before the exam has finished, you will not be allowed to return.
- 11 Do not borrow anything from another candidate during the exam.
