We are planning to invite students on site to collect their examination results. As well as receiving their results, students will be able to access support with any queries about UCAS or other career paths.

Students should use the Burr Road entrance. If guidance concerning Covid-19 restrictions changes and we need to make any changes to these arrangements, we will keep you informed via the Academy website.

If your son or daughter is unable to collect their examination results in person, they may nominate another person to collect them. In order to arrange this, please use your email address on record at the academy to send a request to exams@southfieldsacademy.com. The nominated person should bring proof of ID when collecting the results. Uncollected results will be posted home.

In April we shared with you the process used to determine grades this academic year and teachers also shared with students the evidence used to inform these grades. You should be reassured that this process has been fairly and consistently applied. However, if a student believes that something has gone wrong in determining a grade, they can request a centre review and an awarding organisation appeal.
