



Year 6/7 Summer Transition Activities

<p>Week 1 Leadership</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>What is your passion?</u></p> <p>Good leaders are passionate about what they do, care deeply about their work, their passion enthuses others around them. So, what is your passion? What do you want to change in the world?</p> <p>Your task</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a brainstorm of different issues you are passionate about e.g. homelessness, global warming etc. • Rank them in order of what you are most passionate about and find the contact details for your local MP. • Write a persuasive letter to your local MP explaining what you are passionate about and why you care deeply about this issue. <div data-bbox="1046 461 1477 842" style="text-align: right;">  </div>
<p>Week 2 Organisation</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Let's get involved!</u></p> <p>Research your local area for activities you can do for free. It can be as simple as going to a local park. <p>Week 3 Resilience</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>The ideal tutor room</u></p> <p>In September, your tutor group will have their tutor base. Your tutor base is usually where your tutor teaches their timetabled lessons.</p> <p>Create a 3D model or bird's eye view map of the ideal tutor room. <p>Week 4 Initiative</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>My journey to school</u></p> <p>The picture to the right shows high school students cross the Ranteangin river on their way home in Maroko village, in Kolaka Utara, Indonesia. I hope that your journeys to school are much less dangerous but for many of you, the journey to school will be a new experience, bringing its challenges.</p> <p>This task requires you to practice your journey to school and take photos on the way. Use these to create a presentation using Google slides (available for free online or on the app store) or print and stick the pictures on A3 paper to present to your class.</p>
<p>Week 5 Communication</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Learning from others</u></p> <p>Communication is a key skill that you will need to develop and use more and more as you grow.</p> <p>For this project, you should interview an older member of your family or friends who has already been to secondary school.</p> <p>Create a list of 5 questions to ask them about their experience.</p> <p>One question you have to ask is 'If there is one piece of advice you would give your old self before you started secondary, what would it be?'</p>
