The Award encourages young people to read for pleasure and vote for their favourite books. It is open to students from all Secondary Schools in Wandsworth and is run by Wandsworth School Librarians.

This year's FAB event has been extra special as we celebrated ten years of the Awards' existence. Our students had a wonderful and unforgettable time. They met and talked to like-minded students from other schools as well as some short listed writers, including Ross Welford – the author of *The 1,000 Year Old Boy* and Eve Ainsworth – the author of *Tender*. They also had an opportunity to meet past winners of the Award such as Rachel Ward, Lisa Heathfield and Alexander Gordon Smith. All of the invited authors made very interesting speeches and answered students' questions. The event was also deeply enriched by students' varied and very creative book presentations. Our students' presentation based on *The 1,000 Year Old Boy* was very well received by the audience and won the praise of Ross Welford himself. During the event the students also had the chance to purchase discounted books and ask the writers to sign them.
