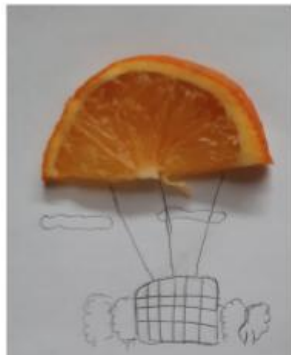

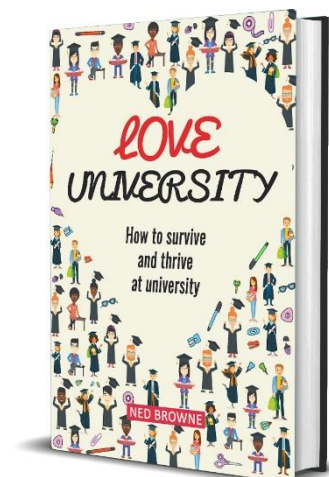

"I think it's very original and exquisite. They are extremely beautiful and elegant. They are ambiguous." Jazab Kang

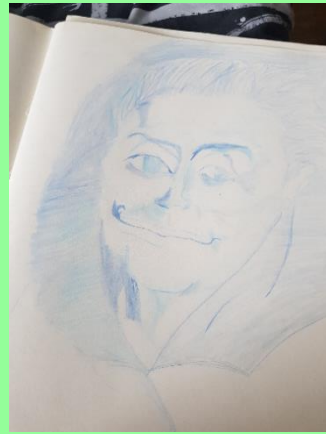
"I think his work is very unique but in a good way. He knew what he was doing and was very talented when it came to drawing and painting..." Ashante Payne

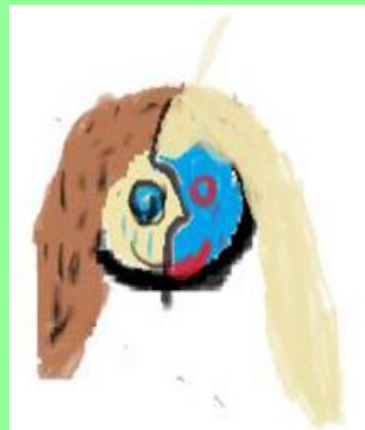
