

Record number of students gain university places – Mr Browne

This year exactly 100 of our Year 13 leavers gained a place at university. The range of courses was remarkable and included: Aerospace Engineering, Architecture, Biomedical Science, Dentistry, Economics, Graphic Design, Journalism, Law, Mathematics, Nursing, Physics, Astrophysics, Product Design, Psychology, Sociology, Civil Engineering, Sports Therapy, Computer Science and Sustainable Energy Engineering.

Moreover, ten students gained places at prestigious Russell Group universities which are recognised as some of the best universities in the world.
