Science Club - Ms El Maadi

To kick off summer term 1 science club, the students got to do some chemical reactions. First, a demo was done called 'the northern light' by mixing hydrochloric acid, calcium chloride and adding little balls of tin foil. Then a lit splint was added to the flask and the flame produced is meant to look like the northern lights.

Then the students tried to do their own chemical reactions. They made hand warmers by mixing calcium chloride and water.
